2021 ANNUAL REPORT

STAKEHOLDER LETTER

Dear Stakeholder,

I am excited to share with you the 2021 accomplishments of Goodwill Industries of the Southern Rivers, Inc. (GoodwillSR) and PowerWorks Industries (PWI), an affiliate organization of GoodwillSR.

Team members from both organizations work every day to generate opportunities for people. They achieve economic stability and make it possible for us to change lives thru the power of work. These pages illustrate how well our mission and financial outcomes align with the vision and objectives of our strategic vision.

At PWI, a company that provides meaningful work for people with disabilities, our team members perform custodial and grounds maintenance work at the United States Army Maneuver Center of Excellence at Fort Benning, Ga. and the Marine Corps Logistics Base in Albany, Ga.

These federal contracts are made possible by the Javits-Wagner O'Day Act, which requires that workers with disabilities perform at least 75 percent of direct labor hours. In 2021, approximately 85 percent of PWI's workforce had a documented disability. Wages paid to workers with disabilities topped \$1.66 million in 2021, further demonstrating our commitment to improve the quality of life for everyone in our community, regardless of ability.

Our career center staff worked tirelessly throughout the quarantine period by shifting their service delivery model from in-person to virtual services. During a time when so many people are out of work, we are proud to be responsible for assisting 4,679 individuals in securing a job in 2021. In addition, we provided free tax return services to 7,675 families resulting in over \$8.7 million in refunds back into the local community.

In December 2020, we were honored by a phenomenal one-time gift from author, writer and philanthropist, MacKenzie Scott. Ms. Scott gave our organization a \$10,000,000 un-restricted gift that we are committed to using to implement programs that we previously could only dream about. In 2021, we decided to donate \$1 million of the gift to the seven technical colleges in our 50-county territory to serve as "gap grants" for students whose scholarships or funding did not cover the total cost of tuition, etc. The first two colleges received gifts totaling \$280,000 in 2021, and the remaining five were donated in 2022.

We also began a pilot program in partnership with Piedmont Regional Hospital in Columbus through which we provide free basic healthcare screenings in our stores such as blood pressure screenings as a means to prevent serious adverse events by way of early detection. Our goal is to expand our healthcare initiative and help educate individuals about the importance of good health and provide information regarding healthcare services that are available to them within their community.

We have also earmarked money to help individuals attain training and certification in areas such as construction, medical/personal care and information technology. Plans are to partner with area technical colleges and other established partners to provide these services.

Our donated goods and retail business also enjoyed a phenomenal year. We exceeded our revenue goals and completed our first rural community expansion project with the addition of a new store in Moultrie, Georgia. The store has performed very well, and the community embraced our presence. Further, our e-Commerce business continues to thrive. In 2021, we expanded our offerings to include books and media such as DVD's, etc.

In summary, GoodwillSR created a total overall economic impact of \$217.9 million in Georgia and \$22.1 million in Alabama^{*}. Further, support of our mission to help families achieve economic stability continued to grow, with 406,217 donations of gently used items sold in our retail stores.

We continue to see how the community shows support to GoodwillSR and PWI, through donating, shopping, contracting with us and spreading the word about the services we offer to help people earn jobs. We are grateful for the trust you place in us.

Amazon Partners With GoodwillSR

TO ASSIST WITH STAFFING NEW FULFILLMENT FACILITY

Amazon Partners With GoodwillSR To Assist With Staffing New Fulfillment Facility Amazon is an American multinational technology company that focuses on e-commerce, cloud computing, digital streaming and artificial intelligence. Amazon decided to locate a new, one-million-square-foot fulfillment facility in Newnan, GA. The tech giant needed assistance in filling multiple positions, they called upon the Goodwill Career Center located in Newnan to help them staff the mega-operation.

Goodwill Career Center Manager, Larry Tucker, worked closely with Amazon's management team to fill approximately 1,600 open positions that would be hired to pick, pack, and ship Amazon customer orders. To achieve that goal, Amazon set up all interviews at the spacious Goodwill Career & Training Center in Newnan. Amazon has partnered with other Goodwill's across the country to facilitate their staffing efforts by utilizing Goodwill staff and their facilities which include reception areas, computer banks, conference rooms and private interview rooms.

To recruit and fill the 1,600 positions, Larry and his team worked alongside the Amazon team to screen and process 75-100 people a day for eight weeks. Applicants made use of Goodwill's computers to finalize and/or update their applications online. In addition, Goodwill Training Center Manager, Barbara de Castro and her team of case managers, collaborated with Amazon to provide support and accommodations to any applicants with disabilities. Further, Goodwill's bilingual staff was on hand to provide translation services as needed. More and more companies, both large and small, rely on Goodwill today to support their hiring and staffing needs.

Meet Contarious Herring

For those impacted by developmental disabilities, securing employment is often a daunting, if not impossible task. Issues with verbal communications and social interaction often make it difficult to integrate seamlessly into the workforce. Such was the case for Contarious Herring. After years of struggling to achieve independence and self-sufficiency, Contarious was introduced to PowerWorks Industries, and his life hasn't been the same since.

PowerWorks Industries is a Goodwill affiliate company that provides a work environment that allows individuals with developmental disabilities to thrive. The organization provides contract custodial and grounds maintenance services to two military installations in Georgia: The Marine Corps Logistics Base in Albany and the Army Manuever Center of Excellence at Fort Benning. These contracts were awarded through the Javitz-Wagner O'Day Act which requires that federal agencies purchase certain services from organizations that employ people with disabilities.

Over 75 percent of PowerWorks' workforce has a documented disability. The key to their success lies in the one-on-one case management services provided to its team members with disabilities. According to PowerWorks Case Manager, Deneen Thornton Hill, Contarious was extremely shy when he first started. Further, he was largely dependent on family to help him function on a day-to-day basis and, in fact, his uncle transported him to and from work each day. However, since coming to PWI, he has truly blossomed.

Not only is the quality of his work very high, Contarious is a tremendous support and encouragement to his entire team. And, perhaps, most telling of his progress are the facts that he is now working two jobs, has obtained his driver's permit and purchased his own car. He is also making plans to move into his own apartment. Contarious is a living example of how the power of work can dramatically change a life.
